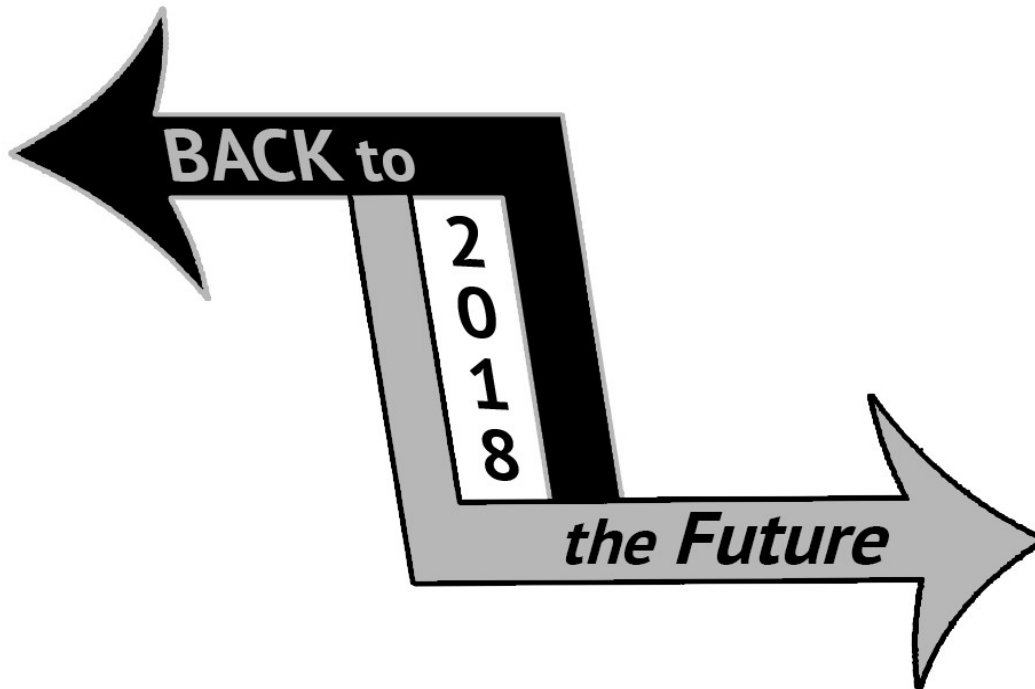

Driving Directions

From the West/Buffalo area:

Take I-90 E/New York Trwy E toward Rochester/Albany

Merge onto I-490 E via EXIT 47 toward NY-19/LeRoy/Rochester

As you approach downtown, merge left onto the Inner Loop/Plymouth Ave. Exit 13. Exit right at St. Paul Street—Turn right onto St. Paul Street. Travel 2 or 3 blocks and turn right onto E. Main Street. Entrance is on the right (just under the skyway bridge)

From Staten Island/NYC area:

I-95 North toward CARS TRUCKS BUSES

At exit 13A, take ramp right for RT-81 N toward Elizabeth Seaport / Newark Airport.

Bear right onto US-1 N / US-1 N 9 / US-9 N

Take ramp right for I-78 West toward Clinton / Garden State Parkway. Keep right onto RT-24 W

Take ramp right for I-287 North toward Mahwah. At exit 41B, take ramp right for I-80 West toward Del Water Gap. At exit 293, take ramp right for I-380 North toward Scranton.

Keep straight onto I-84 W / I-380 N. Take ramp for I-81 North toward Binghamton. Keep straight onto I-86 W / I-81 N / RT-17 W. Keep right onto I-81 N. Take ramp right for I-690 West toward Baldwinsville / Fairgrounds. At exit 1, take ramp right for I-90 West toward Buffalo. At exit 45, take ramp right for I-490 West toward Rochester. At exit 16, take ramp right for Clinton Ave toward Downtown. Keep right onto S Clinton Ave. Turn left onto E Main St., Travel 2 blocks past St. Paul Street/South Ave intersection. Entrance to the hotel is on the right (just under the skyway bridge)

From Albany area:

I-87 North toward Buffalo / Montreal. Keep straight onto I-90 W / New York State Thruway. At exit 45, take ramp right for I-490 West toward Rochester. At exit 16, take ramp right for Clinton Ave toward Downtown. Keep right onto S Clinton Ave. Turn left onto E. Main St. Turn left onto E Main St., Travel 2 blocks past St. Paul Street/South Ave intersection. Entrance to the hotel is on the right (just under the skyway bridge)

From the Binghamton area:

Take ramp right for I-81 North / I-86 West / RT-17 West toward Corning / Syracuse. Keep right onto I-81 N. Take ramp right for I-690 West toward Baldwinsville / Fairgrounds. At exit 1, take ramp right for I-90 West toward Buffalo. At exit 45, take ramp right for I-490 West toward Rochester. At exit 16, take ramp right for Clinton Ave toward Downtown. Around Rochester (Sights to see around Downtown Rochester)

Journey Back in Time (Museums)

Strong Museum of Play (1 Manhattan Square Drive) www.museumofplay.org

A history museum that engages people of all ages with hands-on exhibits and the world's most comprehensive collection of toys, dolls, games and video games.

George Eastman House and Museum (900 East Avenue) www.eastman.org

The institution is located on the National Historic Landmark estate of entrepreneur and philanthropist George Eastman, the pioneer of popular photography and a leader in the development of motion picture film and Founder of the Eastman Kodak Film Company. While in this area, take a stroll down East Avenue and check out the historic mansions.

Susan B. Anthony Museum (17 Madison Street) www.susanbanthonyhouse.org

Located in the Historic Corn Hill District; the Susan B. Anthony Museum & House shares the story of Susan B. Anthony's lifelong struggle to gain voting rights for women and equal rights for all.

The Rochester Scenery (Parks and Cemeteries)

Highland Park <https://www2.monroecounty.gov/parks-highland.php>

Highland Park hosts Rochester's annual Lilac Festival in May, which is the largest festival of its kind in North America and draws spectators from all over the globe. The Rochester Civic Garden Center, housed in Warner Castle, offers public access to a horticultural and botanical library of over 4,000 volumes and sponsors an ongoing series of educational courses. Highland Park is also home to the Lamberton Conservatory

Mt. Hope Cemetery (1133 Mt. Hope Avenue) www.cityofrochester.gov/mounthope

Mount Hope Cemetery is one of the United States' first municipal rural cemeteries. Situated on 196 acres of land adjacent to the University of Rochester on Mount Hope Avenue, the cemetery is the permanent resting place of over 350,000 people, including Frederick Douglass, Susan B. Anthony and General E. G. Marshall. Check out the list of Notable Burials on the website.

A Taste of Rochester

Rochester Public Market (280 N. Union Street) www.cityofrochester.gov/publicmarket

Rochester's City-run Public Market has served the community at its 280 N. Union Street site since 1905. Bargains and local goodness abound Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday, 52 weeks a year. Vendors offer local produce, meats and seafood, eggs and dairy products, ethnic delicacies, prepared foods, specialty items, general merchandise, and more in three covered outdoor vendor sheds and also a brand new state-of-the-art fully indoor shed. In addition, an array of independent local businesses--cafes, food stands, coffee shops, florists, specialty food purveyors, breweries, and more--can be found on Market grounds and in the surrounding Market District.

Black Button Distillery (85 Railroad Street) www.blackbuttondistilling.com

Rochester's first legal craft distillery since Prohibition. See their production and taste the vodka, gin and whiskey produced from New York Grains.
