President Susie Smith reviewed what she had accomplished during the year. She stated she looks forward to the next year.

Vice President Lisa Cartini gave her report. She stated there are 12 clubs with 544 members for the 2018-2019 Year. We had 13 clubs with 592 members for 2017 – 2018 Year.

Recording Secretary Michele Camilleri presented the Minutes for the 2018 Saturday General Meeting for corrections from the membership. There were no corrections. "If there are no objections I, President Susie Smith will accept the 2018 Saturday General Meeting Minutes as presented this day, May 4, 2019 at the 2019 Saturday General Meeting."

2019 State Meeting Chairman Kathy Brousseau and Co-Chairman Kathy Lyman welcomed everyone and reviewed the activities for the weekend. They thanked their club and the local clubs for all they did to help them with this State Meeting.

Treasurer Michele Szatkowski reported the General Fund Financial Report Opening Balance \$7428.42, Total Income \$2885.92, Total Expense \$3189.14 Closing Balance \$7145.21. She then reported Eleanor Siegel Fund Financial Report Opening Balance \$90.39, Total Income \$2529.66, Total Expenses \$2089.61, Closing Balance \$530.44. Lorena Cutt and Glenda Chappell gave the Audit Committee Report. They audited the books and an error was found in the Membership Pins. Expense came out of the General Fund but should have been from the Eleanor Siegel Fund. This transfer will be made before Midterm. It was recommended the Eleanor Siegel Fund be in a savings account.

"If there are no objections I, President Susie Smith will accept the Audit Committee's Report on the General Fund and the Eleanor Siegel Fund as corrected."

MSS Treasurer/Vice Chairman Kathlene Lyman gave the Financial Report for the MSS Fund. Opening Balance \$5159.21 Total Income \$3230.00, Total Expenses \$3500.00, Closing Balance \$4188.21



Lorena Cutt and **Glenda Chappell** gave the Audit Committee's Report. They had reviewed the books and found them to be correct.

 Parliamentarian Mary Grace Roach presented the recommended changes to the By Laws. She discussed the change to Article 2 Section 2b Logo Usage. She asked if there were any questions or discussion. This change was previously published and needs a half plus one affirmative vote.

 "I, Lesley Longmcleod, a member of MOTC Suffolk, at this NYSOMOTC Annual State Meeting, move we accept recommendation to include/amend By Law Article II section 2 B a: A written request is to be sent to the State President prior to the Midterm Executive Board Meeting. The Executive Board shall approve or deny usage of the logo or name." Katrina Smith of Chemung Valley MOTC seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion Passed.

Parliamentarian Mary Grace Roach presented the recommendation by the Executive Board to change the term of office for Elected Officers. Discussion followed.

"I, Shirley Savage, a member of Southern Tier MOTC, at this NYSOMOTC Annual State Meeting, move to change Article V section 2 to read 'no officers shall serve more than one term in the same office consecutively." The motion was seconded by Glenda Chappell. Motion passed with more than 2/3 affirmative vote.

Parliamentarian Mary Grace Roach presented the recommendation by the Executive Board to change the term of office for the Nominating Chairman and the Nominating Committee to take effect for the 2020 – 2021 year.

"I, Shirley Savage, a member of Southern Tier MOTC, at this NYSOMOTC Annual State Meeting, move that we add subparagraph "A" to Article VIII Section 1 to read 'The Nominating Chairman and Committee Members term of office shall be two years or until successors are elected." The motion was seconded by Myriam Lavora. Motion passed with more than 2/3 affirmative vote.

The 2021 State Meeting Bid was tabled until later, for clubs to consider this matter.

Marie Simmons Scholarship Chairman Linda Goldsworthy presented the 2019 Scholarship Recipients Alexandra Cerchia and Eliza Hilfer. A brief statement from each recipient was read by the chairman.



The Community Service Project was discussed by Linda Goldsworthy. Together we made 14 blankets and 21 hats for the Ronald McDonald House in Albany. Members were asked to bring socks and she collected 224 pairs. The Card Project was created with art of Meghan Roach from her Senior Art Project at Alfred University to convey the beauty of diversity. The Meghan Alice Roach Scholarship for Young Artists will receive the funds from the sale of the cards. Michele Camilleri asked the membership to donate one night's hotel products for contribution to the Long Island Coalition for the Homeless.

Midterm Board Meeting Chairman Michele Szatkowski and Co-Chairman Shirley Savage presented the recap of attendance at the 2018 Midterm Board Meeting. There were 35 attendees, 33 Board Members, 7 Past President, 4 Club Presidents and 6 State Reps. The 2019 Midterm Board Meeting will be Saturday, October 19, 2019. We will stay at the Quality Inn in Vestal. Everyone is welcome to attend. Room rates are \$84.95 plus tax unless your club is tax exempt.
