

TWIN PHOTO REGISTRY

The Photo Registry is created to promote bonding and unity among the Member Clubs by providing a visual record of our multiples and their family members. It may include club events, special occasions or members' celebrations. This pictorial project will serve as a permanent record of the multiples and/or families of the clubs who participate.

Photo Albums: The Chair collects the photos submitted by club members and organizes them into an album. Photos are not returned. A brief description of each photo should include the name, date and a description of the event being depicted.

Club Scrapbook Contest Pages: The clubs' submissions to this annual contest are collected by the Chair, at the conclusion of the State Meeting. The pages are placed in a scrapbook size album and displayed at the State Meetings.

Storage: The Chair maintains possession of the albums and stores them properly to avoid any damage.

Participation: Member Clubs' participation is completely voluntary.

Super State Rep Award: Club membership participation earns the State Rep a credit point towards the Super State Rep award. Email the Vice President a list of the clubs who have submitted photos by no later than **March 31st**.

At the State Meeting: Display the photo albums.

Newsletter Articles: Submit articles for the Presidential Papers to promote member clubs' participation.

New albums: The purchase of new albums is approved by the President. For a refund of expenses, submit a voucher form with original receipts.

Executive Board Meetings: Prepare a written report. Provide 8 copies – one each for the Officers and for the Minutes Approval Committee.

Files: copies of reports, badge and the photo and scrapbook page albums are transferred to the incoming Chair or returned to the Procedure Manual Chair at the end of your term.
